

1959 Men's Track and Field Team

In October, at a ceremony in the aptly named Hall of Fame Room, Macalester inducted the **1959 men's track and field team**—the team that began Mac's string of 11 straight MIAC titles—and four individuals into the M Club Hall of Fame. **Allan Andreotti '60** (football/baseball), a four-year letter recipient in both football and baseball, is also a basketball coaching legend in Minnesota. Andreotti has been inducted into the Richfield High School, St. Cloud Tech High School, and Minnesota Basketball Coaches Association halls of fame. **David Fenn '77** (soccer/track & field) held the Mac record for triple jump for two decades in addition to leading the men's soccer team in goals for two seasons. **Brian Nichols '60** (track & field/football) was a four-time conference record holder and MIAC champion in shot put as well as a conference champ in javelin.

Also a force on the football field, Nichols was a four-year letter-winner and a second-team All-MIAC guard. **Kate Ryan Reiling '00** (soccer) was the captain of Macalester's 1998 Division III national championship team, a three-time All-American, and received conference Player of the Year honors as a junior. Reiling is also seventh on the program's all-time scoring list.

for Campbell Trophy

Selected as the best and brightest from the college gridiron, the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame have announced the 147 candidates for the 2012 NFF National Scholar-Athlete Awards, presented by Fidelity Investments. Included is Macalester senior wide receiver Riley Koval (Mount Horeb, Wis.), one of only 41 NCAA Division III players so honored. The 147 nominees are also semifinalists for the 2012 William V. Campbell Trophy, endowed by HealthSouth, which recognizes the best football scholar athlete in the nation.
