***SUMMER LANGUAGE PROGRAM IN NEPALI**

South Asian Studies at the University of Wisconsin-Madison announces its 10 Week Intensive Summer Language Program from June 11 to August 19. The Program is specially designed to meet the needs of individuals who are unable to take language courses during the regular academic year, those students attending an academic institution which does not offer the language needed for field work, and those people travelling to South Asia this fall. Among the courses offered will be:

Elementary Nepali Intensive concentrates on grammar, script, and simple texts in written Nepali keyed to the cultural heritage. Conversation is pointed toward preparation for use in actual social situations as well as toward learning the grammar. Meets 4 hrs./day, 5 days/week. 10 credits for undergrads and special students, 8 credits for grads.
