These disciplines are a typical sample of the principal research in and on Nepal during the last decade. The articles in this book show that interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary approaches towards the many varied cultures of Nepal have become more common. In this way, the volume adds much to the knowledge of certain selected phenomena; it also tries to take into consideration the fact that societies are cultural units and that research in Nepal has to transcend the narrow limits of any one scientific discipline.

About 2300 titles of articles from periodicals and monographs were collected for a bibliography which covers the period from 1975 to 1983.
