



American Song

American Song is a history database that contains ~12,00 tracks that allow people to hear and feel the music from America's past. The database includes songs by and about American Indians, miners, immigrants, slaves, children, pioneers, and cowboys. Included in the database are the songs of Civil Rights, political campaigns, Prohibition, the Revolutionary War, the Civil War, anti-war protests, and more. This release includes 763 albums, equaling 12,542 tracks.

## Keys to Developing a Quality Media Outreach Program

Media projects can provide transformative learning experiences. Always focus on teaching and learning!

- Strive to cultivate relationships with new faculty and grow with past
- Make friends and get out there!
- Collaboration with Smart Learning Commons

   First year of servinar (2008), there was no Smart Learning Commons at Walter Library. The Academic Technicings grant was to support my teaching. Couch 22. There was, in essence, no support for students' digital stories.

   Next year, students came to the Smart Learning Commons and Scott gave them an editing workshop for digital stories. They rented converse and tripods. They sought out technical emistance.

   Because we had access to Smart Learning Common's Viewing Room, we hald a premiere of the students' digital stories at the Smart Learning Commons. We invited interested colleagues and technology stall, as well as the interviewees the students had interviewed for their stories.
- Recruit knowledgeable, passionate, professional staff focused on student learning
- Recruit and heavily train competent, reliable, student staff
- Consult with colleagues at other institutions
- Keep one eye on today and the other on TOMORROW!




