## Macalester President receives \$250,000 senior presidential leadership grant from the Mellon Foundation

St. Paul, Minn. - Macalester College President Brian Rosenberg has been awarded a \$250,000 senior presidential leadership grant from The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation to support initiatives arising from the college's strategic planning process. The grant, which is made by invitation only, will start in September 2014 and end in August 2017.

The grant will support activities in the areas of distinctive programming, technology and teaching, sustainable financial practices and programs, and governance. The funds will be used to create new courses and modify existing ones, provide faculty development, and allow the exploration of cooperative partnerships and alternate forms of campus governance.

President Rosenberg will be the project director for the grant. "With the support of the Mellon Foundation, Macalester will be able to take full advantage of the momentum generated by our strategic planning process," Rosenberg said. "The funding allows us to try compelling new ideas appealing to our community, thereby encouraging a culture that embraces innovation."

Macalester College, founded in 1874, is a national liberal arts college with a full-time enrollment of 2,011 students.
