Thirty-fifth Annual G. Theodore Mitau Endowed Lecture with Prof. Ian F. Haney López



Donald Trump has seized the lead among Republican presidential candidates by attacking Mexican immigrants. Is this a temporary triumph of demagoguery that will surely fade? In his lecture, López shows that, for all his bombast, Trump is following the basic script of conservatives in the United States for the last 50 years: use racial and other status anxieties to scare voters into supporting politicians who ultimately enact policies that benefit their plutocratic funders.

López holds an endowed chair as the John H. Boalt Professor of Law at the University of California, Berkeley, where he teaches in the areas of race and constitutional law. He is also a Senior Fellow at Demos, "a public policy organization working for an America where we all have an equal say in our democracy and an equal chance in our economy." His most recent book is *Dog Whistle Politics: How Coded Racial Appeals Have Reinvented Racism and Wrecked the Middle Class*.
